

OSLS Uniform Policy

We believe these guidelines exhibit a standard of excellence for all students at Our Savior Lutheran School. Final determination and interpretation of the dress code is at the discretion of the administration or administrative designee.

However, we also believe, and agree, that parents are the first teachers of their children, and should have the power to determine which school is the best fit for their child, including consideration of factors such as dress codes and restrictions on hair styles.

All uniforms must be of the correct size and in good repair.

3 day a week uniform/polo shirts

All polos are to be purchased in the school office.

All Grades: Shirts must be long enough to remain tucked in at all times.

Elementary (Grades K-5): Hunter green, grey or white collared shirts with the OSLS crest are to be worn.

Middle School (Grades 6-8): Hunter green (mens button up & womens v-neck) or grey (mens are 3 button, women are 5 button) collared shirts with the OSLS crest are to be worn. Girls may wear a solid black or white tank top under the school polo.

Cooler Days (Grades K-8): OSLS long sleeve crested polos, non-hooded sweatshirts or fleeces (available in the school office), solid navy or white zipper or button down sweaters may be worn over the school polo. Solid black or white long sleeve shirts may be worn under the school polo.

Bottoms

All grades: Uniform bottoms must fall no higher than 3" above the knee in the front and back.

Elementary (Grades K-5):

- Plain solid navy or khaki in a cotton or cotton blend. No sewn on pockets (i.e. cargo or jean style) or elastic/cinched ankles.
- Boys must wear dress style school uniform pants (no elastic ankles) or shorts.
- Girls must wear dress style school uniform bottoms. Black, navy or white shorts should be worn under skirts and jumpers, but may not be longer than the uniform.
- Embroidered jumpers, with the school crest, may be worn with a white collared or school uniform shirt underneath. Jumpers must be approved by the school office before being embroidered. Visit White House Custom Printing for embroidery. (7183 30th Ave. N.)
- Girls may wear solid navy or black tights/ankle length leggings under the uniform bottoms.

Middle School (Grades 6-8):

- Plain solid navy or khaki in a cotton or cotton blend. No sewn on pockets (i.e. cargo or jean style) or elastic/cinched ankles.
- Boys must wear dress style school uniform pants or shorts with belt loops and a belt, and shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Girls must wear dress style school uniform bottoms no higher than 5 inches above the knee. If the bottoms have belts loops, a belt must be worn, and shirts must be tucked in at all times. Black, navy or white shorts should be worn under skirts and jumpers, but may not be longer than the uniform.
- Girls may wear solid navy or black tights/ankle length leggings under the uniform bottoms.

3 day a week/polo uniform shoe policy

Elementary (Grades K-5): Flat bottomed with rubber soles. Socks must be worn every day and must fall below the knee. **Boots may only be worn on half-day, non-uniform days.**

Middle School (Grades 6-8): Shoes or sneakers must have closed toes, sides and heels. No sandals or flip-flops. The sole/heel should not exceed 1" in height.

2 day a week uniform/P.E. days

All grades: Green dri-fit Our Savior Spartans P.E. shirts, and black P.E. shorts, with the school crest, must be worn. They can be purchased in the school office.

Cooler days: OSLS fleeces, non-hooded sweatshirts and sweatpants may be worn in addition to the P.E. uniform. No additional clothing, that is visible, should be worn under the P.E. uniform.

P.E. uniform shoe policy

All Grades: Athletic, rubber soled sneakers, with socks, must be worn

Jewelry

A conservative approach to the use of accessories and/or jewelry is expected. Boys may not wear earrings.

Elementary (Grades K-5): Girls may wear small post earrings with no parts that dangle/fall below the earlobe. No jewelry, other than post earrings, may be worn on PE days.

Middle School (Grades 6-8): A conservative approach to the use of accessories/jewelry is expected. On P.E. days only small post earrings may be worn.

Make-up

No temporary, henna or permanent tattoos are allowed.

Elementary (Grades K-5): No makeup may be worn.

Middle School (Grades 6-8): Girls may wear makeup to school in moderation. However, any make-up brought to school may be confiscated. Boys may not wear make-up.

Hairstyle guidelines for all grade levels

ALL students: The hair should be clean, trim, so both eyes are visible. Colors other than natural tones and distracting hairstyles are not permitted. No designs may be shaved into the haircut.

BOYS: Hair must be above the top of the collar, above the eyebrows, and above the ear lobes. We do not allow hair styles for boys such as: buns, braids, dreadlocks, design cuts, mohawks and other trending styles that do not reflect our standards.

Non-Uniform Day Dress Code Grades K-8

In keeping with our Christian values, students should dress in a conservative manner that represents us as children of God.

- Clothing should be appropriate in length (no higher than 3" above the knee), fit, and coverage, including complete coverage of shoulders (no cold shoulder cutouts or sleeveless) and midriff (tummy).
- Clothing may not have frayed hems or holes, even by manufacturer design.
- Inappropriate words, pictures or logos should not be worn.
- Shoes must be in accordance to the uniform dress code so that students can participate in outdoor activities and P.E. as needed. **Boots may only be worn on Noon dismissal non-uniform days.**
- Leggings, Joggers, jeggings, skinny/tight jeans, yoga pants or any lycra, spandex or form fitting bottoms may only be worn with a top that falls at least mid-thigh.

If in doubt, don't wear it!
